# Why is it Important to Attend Falls Assessment Clinic?

When you have fallen once, you have a **higher chance** of falling **again**.

#### Fall injuries can lead to

- \* Hospitalisation
- ✗ Loss of independence
- × Death

- Polyclinics
- Specialist Clinics

# Consult with the Geriatrician

- Identify and modify risk factors for falls
- Learn to protect your bones



## Health check-up by the nurse

- Blood pressure
- Height and weight
- Vision
- Memory



## Review by the Physiotherapist

- Check muscle strength and balance
- Assess posture and walking



# Discussion with the nurse

- History of falls
- Geriatric assessment
- Falls precaution education

## **Preparing Your Visit to the Falls Assessment Clinic**



Visit will last for approximately two hours.



You are welcome to bring a friend or relative.



Please bring along any medications you are taking.

## What Happens After the Falls Assessment Clinic?

#### 1. Additional Assessment

You may be asked to go for basic blood tests, bone health scans (BMD), heart tracing (ECG), and other tests as required.

#### 2. Professional Recommendations

You will receive a letter summarising the reasons for falling and any recommendations specifically for you.

#### 3. Specialist Referrals

Additional referrals may be given to see other specialists, including:


- Orthopaedics
- Ear, Nose & Throat
- Physiotherapy

- Neurology
- Ophthalmology
- Occupational Therapy
