Introduction

The Combined Connective Tissue Disease – Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension (CTD-PAH) programme serves to manage and treat patients with connective tissue diseases (autoimmune disorders) who are at risk or have developed pulmonary hypertension. The CTD-PAH programme enables patients to receive comprehensive management and care of their medical condition(s), through cross consultations with various healthcare professionals, all within the same day.

Patient journey



REGISTRATION

Patient arrives at Changi General Hospital Medical Centre and registers at the 4A Cardiac Clinic.



CONSULTATION

Patient will either see the rheumatologist or cardiologist depending on their appointment. During this consultation, the doctor will assess if the patient requires additional consultation(s)*.



ADDITIONAL CONSULTATION(S)*

If additional consultations are necessary, appointments (either joint or sequential) with the healthcare professionals will be scheduled for the patient on the same day. **Sequential consultations: Two separate consultation appointments held on the same day.**



PAYMENT & APPOINTMENTS

The patient pays for the consultation(s) and schedules the follow-up appointment(s) at the 4A Cardiac Clinic counter.

*Joint consultation will be recommended by the doctor if deemed necessary.

Consult with two or more healthcare professionals on the same day
